



FREE THREE-DAY BEREAVEMENT PROGRAM IN APOPKA, FLORIDA
April 21-23, 2017

Youth ages 7-17 who have experienced the death of a parent, sibling, or guardian are invited to register for a weekend of mentorship, support, and group activities.



The Mark Wandall Foundation and Comfort Zone Camp are partnering to provide a three-day bereavement camp program for children and teens in Apopka, Florida the weekend of April 21-23, 2017.



A weekend of healing can begin a lifetime of change.

This 3-day program is designed to:

- Break the isolation children often feel after a death
- Introduce peers who can personally relate to their loss
- Provide mentorship and professional therapeutic services
- Identify healthy coping skills for managing grief



In addition to traditional camp activities, campers and mentors attend age-based support groups where they can talk about their experiences and receive support from children their own age.
